

NOTICE

This is to inform you that the final year project evaluation of the BIT degree program will be **postponed** until **mid of March 2021** due to the country's prevailing situation.

The evaluation will be rescheduled **two weeks after** the final date of the **semester six (06)** examination.

Accordingly, the UCSC has decided to provide the following opportunities for candidates to complete their projects within the current project cycle. These decisions are made considering the prevailing situation in the country, and they are **NOT** applicable for future project cycles.

1. The candidates who failed to register for the project in 2020 can register by paying the registration fee and other applicable surcharge fees **on or before the 15th of November 2020**. These payments can be made online. Those who are willing to register now, need to email their willingness to aredc@ucsc.cmb.ac.lk soon to make the payments system activated. The candidates shall also be required to submit an **extended proposal** on or before the **15th of November 2020**. The content required for the extended proposal is updated in the **project VLE**.
2. The candidates who have registered for the project this year but **failed to submit the proposal** can continue the project by submitting an extended proposal **on or before the 15th of November 2020**.
3. The candidates who have submitted the proposal but failed to submit the interim report can continue the project by submitting an interim report **on or before the 15th of November 2020**.

Separate links will be made available via project VLE to upload these documents.

Please note that the project is equivalent to **three courses (8 credits)** in the BIT degree programme and is an extended piece of individual work, intended to occupy a candidate's time from the end of the second year through to the end of the third year covering over 300 hours of work. As such, it is the candidates' responsibility to make sure that they spend adequate time completing the project.

The candidates who fall into the three (3) categories mentioned above should also submit a signed copy of this document with their consent to the project VLE or before 15th of November 2020, if they wish to continue the project within the current project cycle.
